



Retreat Team Application 2016-17

Application process if you wish to be considered for the 2016-17 Retreat Team:

- ✓ Complete the application below by **Tuesday, May 17, 2016**
- ✓ Mandatory Retreat Team training **August 10, 2016 (9:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon)**
- ✓ Teams for individual retreats will be selected at least one week prior to the retreat.
- ✓ Retreats will be held in the following order:
 - Friday, September 30, 2016– Grade 11** (trainings will be held Sept. 27, 28, 29 during lunches)
 - Tuesday, November 15, 2016 – Grade 9** (training will be held at 7:00 a.m. on retreat day)
 - Friday, January 27, 2017 – Grade 10** (trainings will be held Nov. 10, 12 during lunches)
- ✓ If you meet all requirements you may be considered for retreat team leadership for more than one retreat.
- ✓ If you wish to serve on the Grade 11 Retreat Team you must complete and document 30 or more Christian Service Hours by **September 16, 2016**.
- ✓ If you wish to serve on the Grade 9 Retreat Team you must complete and document 30 or more Christian Service Hours by **November 1, 2016**.
- ✓ If you wish to serve on the Grade 10 Retreat Team you must complete and document your entire Christian Service Requirement (including your paper) by **December 16, 2016**

Requirements/Information for Retreat Team Leaders:

- ❑ You will not receive Christian Service Hours for your participation as a retreat team leader.
- ❑ Remember that you are representing DeLaSalle High School and should portray a positive attitude about the school, teachers and mission.
- ❑ A professional/mature demeanor is expected, you are a role model for students younger than you.
- ❑ The following will be considered when making decisions for the team and all teachers and staff are consulted.
 - The manner in which you have carried yourself during your time at DeLaSalle (i.e. language used, treatment of other students and staff, discipline, etc.)
 - Grades and ATTENDANCE
- ❑ All retreat team members must arrange with teachers, in advance, to complete any missing work from retreat day.
- ❑ **ONLY SERIOUS APPLICANTS SHOULD APPLY.** This is NOT simply a day away from school. Your responsibility on this day is important.
