The **Summer History Immersion Program (SHIP)** is a two-week opportunity for high-school students from the Twin Cities to participate in intensive historical research while also experiencing college immersion at the University of Minnesota. Using the resources of the Minnesota Historical Society and the University of Minnesota, SHIP will help students build research skills and permit them to experience the atmosphere of Minnesota's premier public university. SHIP has an emphasis on students from a diverse background.
