









## Girls' Basketball Returns to State Tournament Islanders Defeat St. Anthony 84-51 to Win Section Title

Congratulations to the DeLaSalle varsity girls' basketball team, who advanced to the state tournament with a 84-51 win over St. Anthony Village in the section championship March 9.

The Islander girls return to the state tournament for the eighth time in 12 years, the first trip since 2013, when the team completed a three-peat, earning three consecutive state championships.

DeLaSalle received a random draw in the seeding meeting March 10 and will play #3 seed Winona in the Class 3A quarterfinal on Wednesday, March 15 at 12:00pm at the University of Minnesota's Mariucci Arena. If the Islanders win, they would play Thursday,



March 16 at 2:00pm and classes would dismiss Thursday at 12:44pm. The state championship game is Saturday, March 18 at 6:00pm at Williams Arena.

#### Archbishop Grants St. Patrick's Day Dispensation

Catholics abstain from eating meat on Fridays during the 40-day season of Lent. Recognizing, however, that Friday,



March 17 corresponds with St. Patrick's Day, which "has traditionally been an occasion for joy-filled celebrations in this Archdiocese," <u>Archbishop Bernard</u> Hebda has granted a dispensation from the obligation of abstinence from meat on March 17. Those taking advantage of the dispensation are

encouraged, however, to perform a work of charity, an exercise of piety, or an act of comparable penance during the second week of Lent. The DeLaSalle Cafe will serve corned beef and cabbage as the main entree on March 17. The Cafe serves meatless only options on all other Fridays in Lent.
