



Financial Aid FAQs

Important Information for completing your Financial Aid Application

❑ Important Dates:

- ❖ February 15, 2019 – Preferential date to ensure consideration for all scholarship and grant opportunities
- ❖ February 25, 2019 – Financial aid application deadline
- ❖ March 1, 2019 – Deadline for supporting documentation for financial aid applications
- ❖ Late Applications – Families are always encouraged to apply, even if the deadline has passed; however, DeLaSalle cannot guarantee financial aid for families who apply late

❑ Who should complete an application?

- ❖ All families are encouraged to submit an application
- ❖ One application is required from the household where the student(s) reside, if a student(s) live in multiple households or parents have shared custody; each household is required to apply for financial aid.

❑ Where to obtain an application?

- ❖ Online applications are required and are available at www.mytads.com. We highly suggest that you download the financial aid worksheet in [English](#) or [Spanish](#) and complete it prior to completing the online application
- ❖ When starting the financial aid application, you will need to create a username and password. Please write those down since they will be used again for the financial aid and tuition management modules in TADS.

❑ What do I enter on Section 22 on the application?

- ❖ Enter "DeLaSalle" as the first school in this section
- ❖ Use the dropdown menu for each dependent who will/may attend a tuition charging school in 2019-20

❑ How do I complete my application on-time?

- ❖ To avoid delays in processing your application you should immediately submit photocopies or upload your supporting documentation:
 - 2018 W-2 Statements
 - 2018 1099 Statements
 - Most recent pay stub(s)
 - 2018 Federal Tax Return (or most recent)
 - 2018 Corporate Tax Return, if applicable (or most recent)
 - Documentation for all other sources of income (social security, welfare, food stamps, unemployment, child support, workers compensation, etc.)
- ❖ TADS requires a processing fee of \$34.00, payable directly to TADS, and will not process your application without this fee paid.

❑ When will I find out if I qualified for financial aid?

- ❖ All need-based grants and merit-based scholarships are reflected on the student(s) Tuition Agreement, which is typically sent after the registration process is completed.
